The Committee for North Sydney welcomes a Metro station – but NOT if the biggest and highest commercial building in North Sydney fills almost the entire site.

Our position was well reported by Andrea McCullagh (*Group wants a North Sydney ‘heart’*, July 19, 2018).

Andrea also reported inaccurate statements by Sydney Metro.

An anonymous spokesperson claimed that there would be a public plaza on the site. In fact, there will be a small setback to Miller Street and a narrow lane to Denison Street.

What is Sydney Metro trying to hide, when they make inaccurate claims about a plaza and enhanced amenity?

The Committee for North Sydney is an independent group of North Sydney residents that includes some of the nation’s top architects, planners and urban designers.

The Committee for North Sydney strongly supports the call by the North Sydney Council for a pause in the rush to approve Sydney Metro’s massive private commercial building and for further community consultation.
